**To ride to the Start:** Turn left upon leaving the HQ and allow at least fifteen minutes getting to the Start. There are (road works) traffic lights on Longmoor Road, please take account of this when timing your route to the start, we don't want to hear about riders jumping lights. There is no need to go back & forth to the start as we do not move it once the event has started. No Late Starts.

**Riding Back from the Finish:** Just carry on over the flyover keeping left onto Longmoor road towards Liphook.
