Please find below the start sheet for the New Forest Boxing Day Open 10

This is a fun event to end the year (although we have still seen fast time in previous years). Any profit from the event is being donated (along with profit from our other open events through the year) to our clubs two nominated charities, Oakhaven and the Hampshire and IOW air ambulance. Teas and refreshments will be available on the day for a donation that also goes to the charities so please give generously and we should be close to raising nearly £1000 over our 3 events for this year.

As it is a fun event, fancy dress is encouraged and prizes will be available for the best dressed!

HQ and Parking

Sign on and HQ is Bisterne Village Hall http://www.bisternevillagehall.org and will be open for sign on from 9AM

Please be aware that parking at the hall itself is limited. So if you have a later start and arrive further down the field it is unlikely you will get into the hall carpark.

Large grass verge opposite the hall if addition parking is required (although bear in mind it may be soft at this time of year). There are also a number of laybys along the Ringwood Road which are only a short ride away from the HQ. The key thing is to please ensure that you park clear of the road to avoid creating difficulties for fellow competitors & other road users. We have a large field this year and we don't want to jeopardise the race in future years due to a few badly parked cars!

The Course


Preferred Route to the start and return to HQ from the finish

The P311 course is becoming busier all the time, so in order to ensure safety and a fair ride for all competitors we ask you to take note of the following instructions in order to find your way to the start. We have quite a large field (approx 80 riders) so by keeping non-racing cyclists off the course as much as possible will ensure everyone gets a safe and fair race.

To the Start

From the hall, turn right onto the B3347 Please take a particular care when leaving the hall to wait for a suitable gap in traffic and to avoid impeding riders who may be racing on the course. After 100m turn right onto Dragon Lane so you are then off the course. Continue on Dragon lane and turn Left when reaching the T-Junction. Follow the road t the end and then turn left again onto Moortown Lane. Continue to the end and then turn right to proceed to the start.

To return to the hall after the event you can retrace your steps and therefore avoid riding on the course where people are still racing.

P311 - Full Course Description:

START at first lamp post in Wellworthy Road, proceed west for 30m to new roundabout on B3347.(SU153044). Turn left (CARE – Give Way) onto Christchurch Road, Proceed south via Bisterne and Avon to Sopley one-way system. (5.2m). Turn right over bridge at the Woolpack and retrace to Ringwood via Avon and Bisterne to

FINISH at drain 10 yds south of junction with Hampshire Hatches Lane at Moortown Green. (SU153038)



Safety Notes:

Riders must:

- · Not make U turns in the vicinity of the Start or Finish
- must not warm up on the Course.
- not stop at the Finish but continue to the event Headquarters.
- Not cut corner at Sopley one-way system on 1st right turn as road is two-way at this point
- Take Extra Care:-
 - From start to Moortown Lane busy with houses and side roads, busy garage on Left, finish on Right.
 - Avon Tyrrell Farm sharp bend with possible gravel.
 - Avon Causeway beware of traffic stopping to turn right or emerging onto course.

Any rider observed riding in a manner which may jeopardise his or her own safety, the safety of others and the future of the Sport will be disqualified and reported to the South District Council of Cycling Time Trials.

When navigating to the start. Please take care on exiting the HQ if turning right across the on-coming traffic. If you have later start, also please take particular care not to impede riders from either direction who may already be on the course.

After completing you ride, please be sure to return to HQ in order to sign off, return your number and to check if you are required for an anti-doping test. It is a requirement from 2017 to sign-off after the event and any rider not doing so will be listed as a DNF.

It is recommended that a WORKING REAR LIGHT, either flashing or constant, is fitted

to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.
